

DAP: Chang Khim, Ean Yong to join Selangor exco

KUALA LUMPUR, May 17 — The DAP's Teng Chang Khim and Ean Yong Hian Wah will be part of the Selangor executive council, party secretary-general Lim Guan Eng announced today.

Lim said Teng (picture) would be leaving his last post as Selangor Speaker to join the state executive council headed by Tan Sri Khalid Ibrahim, while Seri Kembangan assemblyman Ean Yong would be retained as a Selangor executive councillor for a second term.

"DAP ADUN Sungai Pinang Teng Chang Khim and Seri Kembangan ADUN Ean Yong Hian Wah are confirmed two of the DAP Selangor state excos with the rest pending announcement after discussions with Pakatan Rakyat (PR) Selangor component parties," Lim said in a statement.

Khalid was reappointed Selangor menteri besar for a second term after PR won a two-thirds majority in Election 2013 by sweeping 44 of the 56 state seats in the country's most industrialised state.

Lim said Teresa Kok and Tony Pua, who are the Selangor DAP chair and deputy chair respectively, would handle discussions on government posts in Selangor on behalf of the party.
