

Tee Siew Kiong on leave from MCA with immediate effect: Soi Lek

KUALA LUMPUR, May 21 – Datuk Tee Siew Kiong is on leave from MCA with immediate effect following his controversial appointment as a Johor executive councillor, said president Datuk Seri Dr Chua Soi Lek.

According to Star Online, Chua said that Tee who is the party's national organising secretary and Pulai Sebatang assemblyman, had been referred to the MCA disciplinary board for accepting the appointment.

Dr Chua added that Tee would not be attending any party function during his leave.

Speaking at a press conference after chairing the MCA central committee meeting here today, he said the action on Tee was in line with the party's decision not to accept any government posts when its performance in the 13th general election was worse than that in March 2008.

However, when asked if the party would be holding an EGM to overturn the earlier resolutions of not accepting any government post, Dr Chua said anything was possible in politics.
