

**PKR to delay party polls**

PETALING JAYA, May 25 — PKR will delay its party elections originally scheduled for this November, owing to a disruption by the country's 13th general election.

PKR delegates at the party's ninth national congress today approved a special motion that provided for the move, which will give the party an additional six months to prepare for internal polls.

PKR secretary-general Datuk Saifuddin Nasution Ismail had tabled a special motion that contained four proposals, including the extension of the current party leadership's term until party polls.

"To give power to the central leadership to extend the term of service for division leaders and MPP to a set period until the elections," Saifuddin said when reading out the motion.

The three-year term for PKR's central leadership was initially set to expire this November 28.

The motion also sought for a mandate for the PKR central leadership to propose an amendment to the party constitution, which is necessary for the polls delay.
