

Be wary of lies that can divide the society – Najib

PEKAN: Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Razak urged the people to be wary of lies that can divide them.

He said they were certain quarters spreading all sorts of stories for their own benefit.

"We must be united as a team against the nonsense being spread around to derail us. We must also show that Pekan is a formidable BN stronghold," he said to supporters during a visit to the voting centre at Nenasi here tonight.

He also cautioned Barisan Nasional (BN) members here to take into account the high number of new voters.

Speaking at the Shah Bandar BN polling district operations centre here , he said 20 per cent of voters here are first time voters.

"We must remember that even though the parents support BN, it may not be the same for their children," he said to a packed room.

He also introduced Peramu Jaya BN candidate Datuk Sh Mohmed Puzi Sh Ali, whom he said had served the people here for more than five years.

Earlier Najib also visited Kelat Rendang Unno branch acting chief Puaddin Mohd Yasin who suffered a stroke.

He then visited the BN polling district operations centres at Tanah Putih and Kampung Lamir.
