

Najib to visit Selangor areas

PACKED SCHEDULE: He will meet residents in all seven parliamentary constituencies

KUALA LUMPUR: DATUK Seri Najib Razak has a packed day-long programme in seven parliamentary constituencies in Selangor today.

Altogether, the prime minister is expected to visit 17 state constituencies spanning all seven parliamentary seats in 12-hours.

Najib will begin his day at 10am with a walkabout in Bandar Baru Selayang where he will join the people for a morning tea session at Gerai Selera Rumpun in the township.

He then proceeds to shophouses in Taman Greenwood in the Gombak parliament constituency for another walkabout at 11.05am.

Residents can meet him at the Gerai Nasi Ayam in Taman Melawati, also in Gombak, at 11.40am, where he is slated for lunch. An hour later, Najib will move to De Palma Hotel in Ampang for a short break before heading for the next event.

At 2pm, Najib will conduct a walkabout in Kampung Baru Ampang and Pekan Ampang.

Another walkabout begins at 3pm around the Petronas petrol station in Taman Seraya, in the neighbouring Pandan constituency.

He will then proceed to Taman Seri Muda, in Kota Raja, where he is slated to arrive at 4.15pm.

He will join a congregation to perform the Asar prayers at Masjid Al-Falah there before attending another walkabout at Plaza Seri Muda at 4.45pm.

It promises to be a fun meet-and-greet session for those who can join Najib for evening tea at Plaza Seri Muda.

At 5.40pm, Najib will attend another walkabout in Section 18, Shah Alam, before proceeding to Concorde Hotel, also in Shah Alam, where he will take a break for dinner at 6.30pm.

His itinerary continues at 8.30pm in Kampung Baru Sungai Buloh in the Subang parliamentary constituency.

Najib is expected to speak during a meet-the-people gathering in the village. Thousands of residents will join him in singing the national anthem, 1Malaysia and Sayangi Selangor songs at the event.

His final programme will be at SJK (C) Kampung Baru Sungai Buloh, in which he is expected to have supper with the people at 9.40pm.
