

A memorable day for Najib at 1Malaysia Patriotic Cycle event

PUTRAJAYA: Thousands of Malaysians gave Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak and his Cabinet ministers a memorable last day in office during the 1Malaysia Patriotic Cycle event here.

Najib, accompanied by Barisan Nasional leaders and his wife Datin Seri Rosmah Mansor, completed a 12-kilometre route on a bicycle across the Putrajaya boulevard and around the Putrajaya lake in about 45 minutes.

"I am thankful, honoured and humbled to have bore this responsibility (as Prime Minister), to offer my service according to the best of my ability.

"Together with the Cabinet and the civil servant teams, we are determined to take Malaysia to a greater height.

"If we are given a mandate for another five years, we will carry on this journey to the very end in Putrajaya," Najib said in a brief address to the crowd at the finishing line of the event.

He was later presented with a cake to commemorate the fourth anniversary of his term in office as well as a framed photograph of the cyclists set against the backdrop of the Prime Minister's Office complex.
