

**Yang di-Pertuan Agong Wants All Quarters To Support Efforts To Restore National Understanding**

KUALA LUMPUR, June 1 (Bernama) -- The Yang di-Pertuan Agong Tuanku Abdul Halim Mu'adzam Shah wants all quarters, regardless of race and belief, to support efforts by Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak to restore national understanding.

He wants principles, like that of parliamentary democracy, constitutional monarchy, diversity, upholding the constitution and the rule of law, be made the core guidance for the process.

"Restoring national understanding should be made a national agenda of priority by all quarters. Whether Malaysia continues to succeed and achieve the status of a high income developed country or a failed country, will depend on the understanding among us.

"Therefore, I want all quarters to preserve and further strengthen the current bond of unity," said the King at the investiture ceremony in conjunction with his birthday celebration at Istana Negara here Saturday.

He also cautioned quarters attempting to sow animosity and create rift among the people for the sake of their narrow agenda to cease the unconstitutional act.

He said strengthening of national unity should not be regarded a task and responsibility of certain quarters only, but should be an agenda for all Malaysians.

"I want the government, under the leadership of Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak to ensure every national development policies is based on a principle that promotes diversity.

"The reality is our future is inter-related and needs one another. All my subjects, regardless of race and religion, should not be neglected," he added.

Tuanku Abdul Halim also reiterated the need for all quarters to accept the results of the 13th general election.

"If there are differences of opinions or dissatisfaction, use the existing court mechanism as provided in the Federal Constitution and the country's laws," he added.
