

Ministry Praises Sabah Traders For Observing Festive Season Price Control Scheme Last Year

KOTA KINABALU, May 26 (Bernama) -- The Domestic Trade, Cooperatives and Consumerism Ministry has praised the attitude of traders in Sabah for adhering to regulations of the festive season price control scheme in conjunction with Harvest Festival, last year.

Its Minister Datuk Hasan Malek said there were no records of offences during the entire festival under the Price Control and Anti-Profiteering Act 2011.

"In the Harvest Festival last year, there were no records of any price control offences nor were there any complaints from consumers," he said.

He told reporters after visiting business premises at the Kota Kinabalu Central Market and to inspect prices of items under the Harvest Festival festive price control scheme at Servay Hypermarket, KK Plaza, here, today.

Hasan said the Ministry has listed 13 essential goods under the price control scheme in Sabah and Labuan, in conjunction with the Kaamatan festival, including chicken and eggs, effective from May 25 to 31, encompassing 24 districts in Sabah and Labuan.
