

JPN Counters Closed In Conjunction With King's Birthday On June 1

PUTRAJAYA, May 29 (Bernama) -- National Registration Department (JPN) counters nationwide will be closed in conjunction with the birthday of Yang di-Pertuan Agong Sultan Abdul Halim Mu'adzam Shah on Saturday (June 1).

According to a JPN statement today, the Federal Territory JPN headquarters and all state headquarters (except Sabah, Sarawak, Kelantan, Terengganu and Kedah) will be closed on June 1 and 2 and reopen on June 3.

The statement said JPN offices in Kelantan, Terengganu and Kedah will be closed on May 31 and June 1 and reopen on June 2 while in Sabah and the Federal Territory of Labuan, they will be closed from May 30 to June 2.

For Sabah and Labuan the additional day is in conjunction with the Kaamatan Festival (Harvest Festival). The offices there will reopen on June 3.

Meanwhile, for Sarawak, where the Harvest Festival is also celebrated (Hari Gawai), JPN's counters will be closed from June 1-4 and services will only resume in June 5. Queries can be directed to JPN's Customer Service Office here at 03-88807067/7071/7077/8203.
