

'Our King' Exhibition To Showcase Nation's Royal Institution

KUCHING, May 30 (Bernama) -- The Sarawak Information Department's three-day pictorial exhibition entitled, 'Our King,' to be held in conjunction with the current Yang Di-Pertuan Agong Tuanku Abdul Halim Mu'adzam Shah's official birthday celebration here, starting Saturday, will showcase pictures and information on the nation's royal institution.

The exhibition will be held in segments - from the history and background of the King, his activities as well as his installation ceremony which was held two years ago.

"It is therefore, a good opportunity for the people, especially students, to come and visit the exhibition, especially during the public holidays," the department said in a statement here Thursday.

Among others, pictorial exhibition on the royal institution, attire, instruments, awards, 'nobat', flags and the king's local and abroad activities will be on display at the event, aimed to explain the role and position of the King's institution and the concept of the royal constitution in the parliamentary democracy system as practised in Malaysia.

It is also to enhance the spirit of love and undivided loyalty of the people to the nation under the Yang di Pertuan Agong.

Also on display will be pictures on various activities of the Yang di-Pertua Negeri Tun Abang Muhammad Salahuddin Abang Barieng, who is also expected to declare open the exhibition on the first day.

This year, Kota Samarahan is hosting the state-level celebrations, starting with a thanksgiving prayer tomorrow at the Samarahan Mosque, to be followed by a tea reception at the Dewan Suarah to be attended by Salahuddin and Chief Minister Tan Sri Abdul Taib Mahmud and other state dignitaries.
