

**King Grants Audience To IGP, Deputy IGP And FT Minister

KUALA LUMPUR, June 3 (Bernama) -- The Yang di-Pertuan Agong, Tuanku Abdul Halim Mu'adzam Shah, on Monday granted an audience to Inspector-General of Police (IGP) Tan Sri Khalid Abu Bakar and Deputy IGP Datuk Seri Mohd Bakri Zinin at the Istana Negara.
