KUALA LUMPUR, June 4 (Bernama) -- Indonesian Foreign Minister Dr Marty Natalegawa regards the bilateral ties between Malaysia and Indonesia as being at its best.

He described the Malaysia-Indonesia relations as dynamic and positive because it involved numerous levels of societies from both countries.
