

**PKR To Decide Wednesday night On Parliament Boycott - PKR Veep

KUALA LUMPUR, June 12 (Bernama) -- Parti Keadilan Rakyat (PKR) will hold a political bureau meeting tonight to discuss whether it should boycott or join its allies DAP and PAS to attend the first session of the 13th Parliament on June 24, said its vice-president N Surendran.

He said the meeting would be held at the party's headquarters in Petaling Jaya.

Some PKR leaders had recently called for a boycott of the swearing-in of new Members of Parliament to protest alleged fraud in the 2013 General Election (GE13).

While PKR awaits a decision, DAP and PAS have openly voiced their objection to the boycott idea, saying that there was never any consensus on shunning the swearing-in process.

Meanwhile, an online news portal media reported that PKR's Wanita wing chief Zuraida Kamaruddin disagreed with the suggestion that the party should boycott the swearing-in, as it would prevent the opposition pact from representing their voters effectively.
