

Kelantan State Assembly Thanking Nik Aziz For Service

KOTA BAHARU, June 18 (Bernama) - The state assembly today recorded thanks and appreciation to Datuk Nik Aziz Nik Mat who was Kelantan Menteri Besar for 23 years.

The motion proposed by Azami Mohd Noor (PAS-Kadok) was passed unanimously by all the state assemblymen.

Nik Aziz (PAS-Chempaka) who is also PAS spiritual leader was appointed Kelantan Menteri Besar since PAS ruled the state in 1990 until the 13th general election (GE13).

Datuk Ahmad Yakub, the Deputy Menteri Besar in the previous state government, was appointed as Kelantan Menteri Besar.

Earlier, during debate supporting the motion, government backbencher Mohd Zaki Ibrahim (PAS-Kelaboran) accused the Barisan Nasional (BN) government of failing to inculcate Islamic values compared.

"I received information that Gua Musang residents are going to Ipoh (Perak) and Kuala Lumpur just for gambling," he said.

The claim was disputed by Mat Yusuff Abdul Ghani (BN-Nenggiri) who asked Mohd Zaki to produce proof of the allegation.

"The Kelaboran state assemblyman must prove that Gua Musang residents had gone to Ipoh for gambling," he said.

However, Mohd Zaki failed to give a detailed explanation despite claiming to have proof.
