

**Black 505 Gathering Still Classified As Illegal - Police

KUALA LUMPUR, June 20 (Bernama) -- Police maintain the classification for the 'Black 505' gathering expected to be held at Padang Merbok this Saturday, as illegal because the organisers did not receive the approval from Kuala Lumpur City Hall (DBKL).

Dang Wangi police chief, ACP Zainuddin Ahmad said the planned gathering would be completely wrong if the organisers insisted to proceed with it as it would violate Section 11 of Peaceful Assembly Act 2012, which requires the land owner or occupant's approval.

Speaking to Bernama when contacted, Zainuddin said police would investigate the matter based on the existing legal provisions if the organisers insisted to hold the public rally.

The gathering, organised by the opposition pact, is to protest against the 13th general election results.
