

PPP General Assembly To Be Synchronised With Party Polls

KUALA LUMPUR, June 29 (Bernama) -- The 60th General Assembly of the People's Progressive Party (PPP) has been postponed and will be held simultaneously with the party's polls scheduled before June 2 next year.

PPP president Datuk M. Kayveas said the party's supreme council took this decision today in view of the fact the five-year period for the party's polls was until June 2014.

"The last time party elections were held was in 2009. As there are not much activities and decisions made at the general assembly, the supreme council Saturday decided to postpone the general assembly and have it together with the party polls," told reporters after the meeting here.

He said the meeting also decided that PPP set up a sub-committee to be headed by its assistant secretary-general Simon Sabaphaty to make several amendments to the party constitution.

He said among the changes to be made were trimming down the supreme council from the 45 members currently to a more suitable number.

Another change, Kayveas said, was appointing coordinators for each state constituency to assist divisions and branches in coordinating party activities in each state.
