

Kit Siang: Less spin, more action on war on crime

Government and police leaders who need consultants to tell them how to do their jobs, are just not qualified to hold their high offices, declared the Democratic Action Party today.

Its leader Lim Kit Siang said this in response to Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Razak's "War on Crime" campaign.

He was referring to the authorities hiring international consultant Frost and Sullivan to study public satisfaction with the police and how safe they feel in Malaysia.
