

Call for RCI into 'Red Bean Army'

There is a call to set up a Royal Commission of Inquiry into the band of cybertroopers who call themselves the Red Bean Army (RBA), which has been allegedly causing disharmony among Malaysians.

Muslim Consumers Association of Malaysia (PPIM) secretary Datuk Nadzim Johan said an RCI would establish who was behind the RBA.

"Based on our information, the RBA has been slandering the government since 2008.

"We want to know who is behind the RBA, who is funding them," he said.

Nadzim accused the cybertroopers of spreading racial hatred in cyberspace.

"We do not want to point fingers on any political party and that is why an RCI is important because they can unearth the truth," he said.

Kelab Wartawan Muda Malaysia president Dzulkarnain Taib echoed Nadzim's call for such an inquiry.

"The RBA is the cause for the series of Black 505 rallies nationwide as they have spread lies on the Election Commission." - June 21, 2013.
