

GE13: Najib distributes helmets, gives BN youths mission to wrest back Selangor

SHAH ALAM: Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak has given youths in the state a mission - wrest back Selangor from Pakatan Rakyat in the coming general election.

Addressing a large gathering of young people here, he said urged them to "paint the town blue" in reference Barisan Nasional's primary colour.

"Our mission is to win. We must win. We will colour the whole of Selangor blue," he said at the Young People's Patriotic Assembly organised by Selangor Barisan Youth and Kelab Putera 1Malaysia at Politeknik Sultan Salahuddin Abdul Aziz Shah here.

Najib was greeted with rapturous applause throughout his speech from the energetic crowd chanting "Tukar" (change) every time Najib paused during his speech.

Najib distributed 22,000 blue-coloured helmets to 22 parliamentary Barisan divisions at the Young People's Patriotic Assembly.

"The Opposition has failed. They have failed to fulfill their promises, they have failed to govern Selangor. We will change the state government.

"Their manifesto is a manifesto of fantasy and delusion, because the Mentri Besar said a manifesto is not a promise," he said.

Najib promised a better administration for Selangor under Barisan in solving various issues including water supply, garbage collection, illegal gambling and massage parlours, flash floods and sand smuggling. He then distributed 22,000 blue-coloured helmets to the 22 parliamentary Barisan divisions.
