

GE13: Tun Abdullah confident that Barisan will perform better in general election

KEPALA BATAS: Former Prime Minister Tun Abdullah Ahmad Badawi is confident that Barisan Nasional will perform better in the upcoming general election compared to the last general election in March 2008.

He said he believed that Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak's extensive transformation programmes would help deliver more support for Barisan this time around.

Abdullah said the coming election was expected to be one of the fiercely fought elections.

He said there was no need for Malaysians to worry or fuss over when parliament would be dissolved.

"The Prime Minister may have his reasons for not calling for parliament to be dissolved just yet.

"Anyhow, so long as it is done within the timeframe permitted, then I do not see anything wrong with it," he told reporters after opening a Jiwa Murni community programme in Kampung Permatang Sintok here, Saturday.

Abdullah, who is also Kepala Batas Member of Parliament, declined to comment if he would seek re-election to retain his seat.
