

**Opposition Pact Files Suit To Declare GE13 Results Of All Parliamentary Seats Null And Void**

KUALA LUMPUR, July 15 (Bernama) -- The opposition pact, comprising PAS, DAP and Parti Keadilan Rakyat (PKR), and five individuals today filed a lawsuit against the Election Commission (EC) seeking a declaration that the 13th general election results for all the 222 parliamentary seats were null and void.

The five individuals named as plaintiffs in the suit are Dzulkefly Ahmad, M. Manogaran and Saifuddin Nasution Ismail, who were candidates in the general election, while the other two, Arifin Abd Rahman and R. Abbo were voters.

The suit was filed at the High Court registry here through the legal firm of Messrs. Tommy Thomas.

EC chairman Tan Sri Abdul Aziz Mohd Yusof, his deputy Datuk Wan Ahmad Wan Omar and five EC members, namely Datuk Mohamad Ramji Ali, Datuk Dr. P. Manogran, Datuk Christopher Wan Soo Kee, Datuk Md Yusop Mansor and Abdul Aziz Khalidin were named defendants in the suit.

In the statement of claim, they stated that the EC had failed to carry out its responsibilities, and with malice and dishonestly cheated voters with the use of indelible ink during the 13th general election.

They also claimed that the EC had planned the fraud on voters by intentionally allowing the ink to dilute to make it easy for voters who were not honest to vote twice.

Besides seeking the court to order a re-election, they also want all the defendants to be removed from as EC members, as well as general and exemplary damages, interest and other relief deemed fit by the court.
