

**Malaysia Can Bring Change Hoped For - PM
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PUTRAJAYA, July 16 (Bernama) -- Besides succeeding in guaranteeing an environment that is harmonious, peaceful and stable, Malaysia is blessed because it can also make changes for the better, in line with the aspirations of the current generation, said Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak.

He said many events abroad now saw examples of failure of countries to implement changes their people hoped for, despite they being in an environment of peace and stability.

He cited as examples certain countries in the Middle East, which were clearly unable to bring about the changes their people wanted and in the end led to disappointment.

He said the lesson to be learned from these developments was that Malaysians should value what they have, because it was far better than from something that was unknown, even if this came with all kinds of sweet promises.

Najib said this to some 2,000 students of local public and private universities who had joined him in breaking the fast at the compound of his official residence, Seri Perdana, here Tuesday night.

Also present were his wife Datin Seri Rosmah Mansor and International Trade and Industry Minister Datuk Seri Mustapa Mohamed.

Najib said as Muslims, in order to bring about transformation, fasting was very effective holistically to make a success of this effort, whereby it should be appreciated not only from its calling, but in terms of its philosophy and teaching.

"We can make fasting a foundation to transform ourselves to become models for others to follow by showing good conduct, patience and discipline.

"All these can be surmised as good training for us, and an opportunity to improve ourselves," he said.

The Prime Minister later presented Aidilfitri alms to 40 orphans from Rumah Amal Limpahan Kasih, Puchong.

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
