

MCA Members, BN Supporters Must Counter Statements That Try To Undermine Government

ALOR SETAR, July 6 (Bernama) -- MCA will ask its members and Barisan Nasional (BN) supporters to counter all malicious statements and lies posted on the social media websites aimed at bringing down the government.

MCA vice-president Datuk Seri Chor Chee Heung said slander against the BN government during the recent 13th general election (GE13) campaign through the social media websites had partly contributed to the defeat of many BN candidates.

"The opposition had used the social media websites during the recent general election to campaign where they made baseless accusations against the government.

"The people, on the other hand, tended to accept totally what were written on these websites without first analysing or checking to see whether the allegations were true or not."

He said this after handing out contributions under the 1Azam programme to 37 single mothers, here, Saturday.

"We will ask our members and supporters to counter the false allegations. The truth and untruth are lumped together on the social media websites, making the people confused and unable to think rationally.

"Look at Singapore; it has curbed freedom of expression on the social websites because a lot of untruths had been disseminated with ease.

"In Malaysia, we still have an open attitude towards the social media as we don't want to stop people from expressing their views but they must ensure that what they write is the truth," he said.

Chor, who is former housing and local government minister, said the people must be educated not to accept all information posted on the social media as true.

On another note, he said although BN failed to retain the Alor Setar parliamentary seat and a number of state seats, it still delivered on its promises made.

"We hope that with the 1Azam assistance, they (the single mothers) can independently earn a living," said Chor who failed to retain the Alor Setar seat in the GE13.
