

**PR wants 'acceptance of GE13 results' removed from note of thanks to King

Pakatan Rakyat said it has resolved to remove remarks concerning the acceptance of the 2013 General Elections results from the Parliament's note of thanks to the King.

Opposition Leader Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim pointed out that as both Barisan Nasional and the Opposition had filed election petitions to challenge the results, it was not appropriate for the part to be included in the note for Yang di-Pertuan Agong Tuanku Abdul Halim Muadzam Shah.

"We express our gratitude to his royal decree. Election petitions have been filed so we are considering proposing an amendment because we feel it is inappropriate to include the endorsement of the election results," Free Malaysia Today reported him as saying.

"If we give our endorsement to (the note) then the petitions will mean nothing. So we will propose a motion to remove the validation of the election results," the PKR de facto leader said in his Parliament office yesterday.

Anwar said a committee, with members of the three parties in the pact, will be submitting a proposed amendment to the note after going over the issue.

The King had called on both BN and the Opposition to accept the results of GE13 in his Royal Address in Parliament on June 24, following claims of electoral fraud and irregularities. - July 10, 2013.
