

Five states told to amend conversion law by DAP MP

Five states in Malaysia must amend their Islamic administration enactments to stop the unconstitutional conversion of minors to Islam, said DAP Taiping MP Nga Kor Ming in Parliament today.

Nga said the enactments in Negri Sembilan, Perak, Kedah, Malacca and Sarawak are inconsistent with the country's supreme law which requires the consent of both parents for conversions.

He said the amendments have to be made following the withdrawal of the Administration of the Religion of Islam (Federal Territories) Bill 2013 which would have allowed the conversion of a child to Islam with the consent of one parent. - July 11, 2013.
