

**Penang's appointment of coordinators allegedly politically motivated**

The Penang government's move to appoint coordinators for state constituencies won by Barisan Nasional is politically motivated and not to aid the people.

State opposition leader Datuk Jahara Hamid (BN-Telok Air Tawar) said the Penang government was only wasting public money as the BN state assemblymen were able to help the people.

"BN state assemblymen can help the people, no need for the state government to appoint coordinators in constituencies under BN," she told reporters after the opening of the state assembly in Town yesterday.

Yesterday, Chief Minister Lim Guan Eng announced the appointment of coordinators in ten constituencies where Pakatan Rakyat lost to BN in the 13th general election, reported Bernama.

The coordinators appointed are for Bertam, Pinang Tunggai, Penaga, Sungai Dua, Permatang Berangan, Telok Air Tawar, Sungai Acheh, Pulau Betong, Telok Bahang and Bayan Lepas. - July 3, 2013.
