

Najib Breaks Fast With Ulama, Umara, Muslim NGOs

PUTRAJAYA, Aug 1 (Bernama) -- Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak Thursday night attended the breaking of fast with ulama, umara and Muslim non-governmental organisations (NGOs) at Seri Perdana here.

Also present were the prime minister's wife, Datin Seri Rosmah Mansor, Minister in the Prime Minister's Department Datuk Seri Jamil Khir Baharom, former prime minister Tun Dr Mahathir Mohamad and his wife, Tun Dr Siti Hasmah Mohd Ali, and National Fatwa Council chairman Tan Sri Dr Abdul Shukor Husin.

Among NGOs represented were Sekretariat Ulama and Umara Putrajaya, the Muslim Welfare Organisation Malaysia (Perkim) and Yayasan Dakwah Islamiah Malaysia (Yadim).

At the event, Najib handed out aid Aidilfitri aid from the Federal Territories Islamic Religious Council's Baitulmal to deserving recipients, including the poor and Muslim converts totalling RM6 million.

Forty orphans from Rumah Nur Kasih Bestari Segambut and Rumah Nur Muhamad Shah Alam also received aid from Najib and Rosmah.
