

**PM Spends Time To Distribute Bubur Lambuk' At Ramadan Bazaar

SHAH ALAM, July 22 (Bernama) -- Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak spent time today to distribute 'bubur lambuk' or porridge prepared by the 1Malaysia For Youth (IM4U) volunteers at the Section 13 Ramadan Bazaar which is a public attraction, here.

Najib, who arrived at 5pm, spent almost 20 minutes to distribute the porridge to patrons of the Ramadan Bazaar who had formed a long queue since 4.30pm to wait for the arrival of the country's number one leader.

A 16-year-old youth, Fatin Marissa Abdul Aziz from Petaling Jaya Selatan, when approached after receiving the porridge said she felt proud and very happy to have met the Prime Minister.

Meanwhile, IM4U executive committee member, Datuk Irmohizam Ibrahim told reporters that the distribution of the porridge was part of the programme organised by IM4U during the Ramadan month.

He said 112 locations for the Ramadan Bazaar throughout the country had been selected for the 'bubur lambuk' programme where the porridge would be cooked and distributed by the IM4U volunteers throughout the fasting month.

"It's just that today is most fortunate because Yang Amat Berhormat Datuk Seri Perdana Menteri himself came down to join the crowd and cheer up the volunteers cooking the bubur lambuk," he said.

A total of 2,000 packs of 'bubur lambuk' were distributed today in Shah Alam and 150 packs were specially set aside to be distributed in the presence of the Prime Minister, he added.
