

EC challenges Rafizi to repeat allegation outside parliament

Election Commission chairman Tan Sri Abdul Aziz Mohamed Yusof (pic) today challenged Pandan MP Rafizi Ramli to repeat his allegation that the supplier of the indelible ink was linked to the EC leadership outside parliament.

Abdul Aziz told reporters at the Gong Kemuntong district council hall that they were upset because they could not answer his allegations in Parliament.

"It is upsetting that our names were mentioned in Parliament and we could not defend ourselves.

"Therefore we would like to challenge him to repeat his statement outside parliament," Abdul Aziz said.

Rafizi recently alleged that the supplier of the indelible ink used in the 13th general election was closely linked to Abdul Aziz and his deputy, Datuk Wan Ahmad Wan Omar, a claim which the EC leadership described as a malicious lie.

Rafizi had also said that the contract to supply the indelible ink was awarded through direct dealing and added that the owner of the company, Mohamed Salleh Mohamed Alli, was also given contracts to supply hats in the recent general election through three other companies linked to him.

The three companies were Nash Ventures Sdn Bhd, Ayumi Resources Sdn Bhd and Bumi Textiles Sdn Bhd. All three received contracts through direct deals. July 24, 2013.
