

**Banners supporting HM at Seri Pristana bad for non-Muslim students, says MCA

MCA has today condemned the public support rallied for SK Seri Pristana headmaster.

Its national organising secretary Tan Chin Meng said that this were irresponsible and unethical acts because it targets the students.

According to Free Malaysia Today, Tan said this in response to reports of banners being hung outside the gates of the school in Sungai Buloh, to show support for Mohamad Nasir Mohd Nor.

The online portal said Tan had in a statement said this act was daunting and constrains the non-Malay students.

He added that allegations that the headmaster had been taking photographs of the non-Muslim students was an act of intimidation and debilitation.

"If it is true, this behaviour is vile and stern action must be taken at once," he said.

"It is one matter for average people to take these methods, but, the headmaster has joined in as well, further tainting his already sullied name."

Tan called for the banners to be taken down immediately and that Mohamad Nasir be dealt with severely.

The SK Seri Pristana school fiasco was exposed after a parent posted a photograph of non-Muslim students eating in the school's shower-changing room. – August 2, 2013.
