

Najib Appreciates UK Making Visa Applications Smoother For Malaysian Students

KUALA LUMPUR, Aug 16 (Bernama) -- Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak today expressed his appreciation to the United Kingdom government for making visa applications smoother for Malaysian students furthering their studies in that country.

"My thanks to the UK government for making visa applications smoother for Malaysian students going to study there," said the prime minister.

He said this on his Twitter account when commenting a news report on the United Kingdom easing student visa applications.

Britain has granted two significant exemptions in the visa application process for Malaysian students - they no longer need to provide documentary evidence of financial maintenance and educational qualifications.

Deputy High Commissioner Ray Kyles said these requirements had been removed due to the high degree of immigration compliance from Malaysian students.
