

**I Aspire To Rejuvenate Wanita Wing, Says Azalina

KUALA LUMPUR, Aug 22 (Bernama) -- Member of Parliament for Pengerang Datuk Seri Azalina Othman Said said she was offering herself to contest the Wanita Umno chief post as she wanted to rejuvenate the movement.

"This is in line with Umno president Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak's drive to transform and revitalise Umno.

"If elected, I plan to bring some changes and approaches to the Wanita wing as I don't want to see a tsunami of young people against Umno in the 14th general election.

"The party's polls this time around is a healthy competition to ensure that Umno remains relevant to the Malays," she told reporters after being interviewed on BernamaTV's Hello Malaysia programme Thursday night.
