

ROS Ready To Accept Letters From DAP Representatives

KUALA LUMPUR, Aug 24 (Bernama) -- The Registrar of Societies (ROS) is ready to accept all the 500 original acknowledgment letters from DAP representatives claiming to have attended the party's central executive committee (CEC) election last December.

Its director-general Datuk Abdul Rahman Othman said the letters should not be photostat copies for authentication purposes.

"We are confident these 500 letters can help the Registrar of Societies to investigate complaints made by DAP members wanting a re-election," he said in a statement here Saturday.

He said it was 'strange' that DAP leaders volunteered to submit letters from 500 delegates when it was understood that not many of them were present at the CEC election.

He added the ROS had yet to receive even one of the 500 letters mentioned by DAP leaders, although they announced to do so about four days ago. On July 30, the ROS decided DAP must hold fresh party polls after the body was not satisfied with the explanation given by DAP over alleged voting irregularities and manipulation of votes involving 547 delegates at the party's Dec 15 election.

However, the party had repeatedly maintained that the election was held in a clean manner and errors that occurred were due to technical problems.

DAP initially objected to ROS' instructions but eventually decided to abide by its orders.
