

Sabah Umno Leaders Advised Not To Get Over Excited About CM's Candidacy

KOTA BELUD, Aug 24 (Bernama) -- Sabah Umno liaison deputy chief Datuk Seri Salleh Said Keruak has advised state Umno divisional leaders not to be over excited and jump into conclusions over the possibility of Chief Minister Datuk Seri Musa Aman contesting for one of three Umno vice-president posts in this year's party election in October.

"I wish to emphasise that Musa, who is also Sabah Umno liaison chairman, has not made any decision on the matter. So, the question of contesting (for the Umno vice-president post) does not arise.

"Sabah Umno has only expressed full support for Musa should the latter decide to contest for the post," he told reporters after attending an Aidilfitri open house organised by Barisan Nasional (BN) elected representatives, here today.

Among those present were Musa, Former Melaka Chief Minister Datuk Seri Mohd Ali Rustam, Housing and Urban Wellbeing Minister Datuk Abdul Rahman Dahlan and Tempasuk Assemblyman Datuk Musbah Jamli.
