

PM Gets Invite To Open PBB General Assembly

KUCHING, Aug 28 (Bernama) -- Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak is expected to open the 13th general assembly of Parti Pesaka Bumiputera Bersatu (PBB) on Oct 21.

PBB senior vice-president Datuk Amar Awang Tengah Ali Hasan said today an invitation had been sent to the prime minister, who is also Barisan Nasional (BN) chairman and Umno president, to open the assembly.

"The 13th assembly will see the attendance of 2,157 delegates from the men's, women's and youth wings of the party as well as observers. The assembly will be held at the Borneo Convention Centre Kuching from Oct 18 to 22.

"The assemblies of the youth and women's wings will be held on Oct 18 and 19 and the assembly of the men's wing and the general assembly on Oct 21 and 22," he told a news conference after chairing a meeting of the organising committee at the PBB headquarters in Jalan Bako.

Awang Tengah said a seminar on PBB's struggle of more than 50 years to develop Sarawak would be held on Oct 20 in conjunction with the assembly.

He also said that 39 PBB branches had completed their respective delegates' meetings.

"Thirty-two other branches have to hold their meetings.

"We have instructed all the branches to complete their meetings by Sept 15," he added.
