

**Do Not Let Umno Elections Disrupt Unity - Mohd Isa

BENTONG, Sept 4 (Bernama) - Candidates vying for Umno top posts in the party elections next month have been reminded to ensure that the contest does not disrupt unity.

Felda chairman Tan Sri Mohd Isa Samad who is contesting for one of the three vice-president's post said the candidates should comply with the party rules.
