

**Anwar's pitch for dialogue a desperate move, says Khairy

The opposition's call to Putrajaya to have talks is a desperate move brought on by its failure to win election petitions disputing the May 5 general election results Umno Youth said today.

Youth chief Khairy Jamaluddin (pic) questioned Anwar's motive in wanting such a dialogue now, especially when Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Razak had mooted the idea soon after the 13th general election.

"The Prime Minister had offered to have a dialogue with them but they were not interested and petitioned the election courts over the outcome of the polls.

"But now when the courts rejected their petitions they want to have a dialogue," he said at the Youth wing's Hari Raya open house.

Anwar signalled his readiness to engage Barisan Nasional in a dialogue when he announced today that the opposition was ready to accept the results of the general election.

Anwar, in his Merdeka Day speech, also pushed for a quick meeting between both parties to solve various issues plaguing the country.

"The meeting between both sides must be held immediately to save Malaysia, especially in light of the country's 56th birthday tomorrow," he said.
