

Don't Send Umno Members Into Disarray, Zambry Tells Candidates

IPOH, Sept 11 (Bernama) -- Umno leaders and candidates vying for positions in party polls at the divisional, state and national levels should not be overzealous as their actions could send members into disarray.

Perak Menteri Besar Datuk Seri Dr Zambry Abdul Kadir said it was unbecoming of certain quarters to resort to uncalled for behaviours such as resorting to money politics, forming camps, and nurturing hostility and hatred towards contending leaders and candidates.

"Umno members need to do a paradigm shift by electing truly magnificent leaders. If we fail to choose them, we will continue to repeat mistakes and eventually ruin the party," he told reporters after chairing the state executive council meeting here on Wednesday.

He said it was unfortunate if Umno members were to become hostile against one another and fail to learn from recent events as well as the outcome of the 11th, 12th and 13th general election (GE) as if party polls took precedence over the GE.

"Party polls should be held in a family spirit by accepting whoever wins or loses with an open heart," he added.

On an uproar at the Pekan Batu Gajah Umno branch delegates' meeting, Zambry, who is also state Umno liaison committee chairman, said he would seek clarification from the Batu Gajah Umno division over the incident.
