

Fadillah Stakes PBB Youth Chief Post To Top, Grassroots Leaders

KUALA LUMPUR, Sept 17 (Bernama) -- Parti Pesaka Bumiputera Bersatu Sarawak (PBB) Youth chief Datuk Fadillah Yusof has left it to the party's top and grassroots leaders to decide whether he should continue to lead the movement.

Fadillah, who is also works minister, said he was willing to serve the party if his services were still needed and to make way if a change of the PBB Youth leadership had to be done.

He was asked to comment if he would defend his post in the upcoming party's polls in October.

"Contests in party polls are normal in a party practising democracy like PBB.

"But we usually have negotiations as we believe democracy opens up avenues for negotiations. And we listen not only to top leaders but also grassroots leaders.

"And finally, if they want a contest, that is the best decision that must be abided by. Possibly there is no contest at all, this is also common in PBB," he told reporters after officiating Ecobuild Southeast Asia here today.

A total of 250 exhibitors from 22 countries including Canada, China and the United Kingdom are taking part in the event, a leading event for sustainable design, construction and built environment show.
