

Malaysian Pilgrims Advised To Wear Identification Tag At All Times

MADINAH, Sept 9 (Bernama) -- Malaysian pilgrims have been advised to wear at all times the coloured lanyards and badges provided by Tabung Haji (TH) for easy identification in the Holy Land.

For this year's Haj season, TH has provided red lanyards for the pilgrims in Madinah and orange lanyards for those in Makkah, said Madinah TH pilgrimage manager Mohd Razali Zakaria.

"Pilgrims, particularly those who have just arrived, are reminded not to remove the lanyard and identification tag as they can be assisted if they get lost or cannot find their accommodation in the Holy Land," he told reporters here.

Mohd Razali also said that 10 pilgrimage guides would help to conduct the visits of the pilgrims to several holy and historical places, including the Nabawi Mosque, Quba Mosque and Qiblatin Mosque as well as Prophet Muhammad's Tomb.
