

DAP Attempts To Portray It's Multi-Racial, Says Analyst

KUALA LUMPUR, Sept 30 (Bernama) -- A political analyst has described the re-election of the DAP central executive committee (CEC), which saw one Malay leader elected, as an attempt to portray that the party leadership comprises people of the various communities.

Datuk Zainal Abidin Borhan, when contacted on Monday, said having only one Malay candidate on the CEC was insufficient to prove that the DAP was a multi-racial party.

Bukit Bendera MP Zairil Khir Johari, who occupied the 20th position on the CEC at the 2012 DAP national congress, clinched the 12th position this time with 1,132 votes.

The re-election was held after the Registrar of Societies (ROS) did not recognise the CEC of the last election, held in December last year, following complaints of discrepancies lodged by party members.
