

Bung Moktar Claims Umno Delegates Threatened Over Support

SANDAKAN, Oct 3 (Bernama) -- Kinabatangan Umno Division head Datuk Bung Moktar Radin has asked the party's disciplinary board to go down to the ground and monitor electoral candidates in the division who reportedly intimidate delegates holding positions at village level.

Bung Moktar, who is an Umno Supreme Council member, said he had received such complaints from the delegates in the division.

"Threatening delegates holding positions at the village level, particularly the heads of branches, for denying support is an offence and contravenes the party constitution.

"These people had complained that they were threatened with action if they do not support the divisional delegates," he said in a statement here.

He said he hoped that the disciplinary board would monitor the situation and act against the candidates.

Bung Moktar, who is defending his positions as a supreme council member and head of the Kinabatangan division, said the monitoring was necessary to ensure that dirty tactics were not employed to garner the delegates' votes.
