

**IGP Tells Party Supporters Not To Stir Up Tension In Sungai Limau By-election**

YAN, Oct 12 (Bernama) -- The police have advised party supporters, especially those from other areas, not to stir up tension in the Sungai Limau by-election.

Inspector-General of Police Tan Sri Khalid Abu Bakar said such supporters who were not familiar with the culture in Sungai Limau, should not try to threaten voters here.

In this regard, he said no area in the Sungai Limau state constituency was categorised as 'hotspot', and that the police were prepared for any eventuality.

He was speaking to reporters when visiting the Yan police headquarters here Saturday.

Khalid said the police had sufficient personnel on duty at the 19 polling districts and 17 polling centres involving 58 voting streams.

He said his visit to the Yan police headquarters was to observe the preparedness of the police in handling the Sungai Limau by-election scheduled on Nov 4. Nomination is on Oct 23.

The Sungai Limau state seat in the Jerai parliamentary constituency was declared vacant, following the death on Sept 26, of incumbent Tan Sri Azizan Abdul Razak who was the former Kedah menteri besar.
