

Najib Visits Greentech Exhibition Held In Partnership With GES

KUALA LUMPUR, Oct 12 (Bernama) -- Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak today took time off from his busy schedule to visit the International Greentech and Eco Products Exhibition and Conference Malaysia (IGEM) held in partnership with the two-day Global Entrepreneur Summit (GES) 2013.

Najib, dressed in smart casuals and accompanied by his son Norashman and daughter Nooryana Najwa, toured the area for about an hour.

Also present were Minister of Energy, Green Technology and Water Datuk Dr Maximus Ongkili, Multimedia Development Corporation Chief Executive Officer Datuk Badlisham Ghazali and SME Corporation Malaysia Chief Executive Officer Datuk Hafsa Hashim.

Najib launched both events yesterday.

The GES 2013, which ends today, gathered 4,700 delegates including thought leaders and aspiring entrepreneurs from 100 countries, to share their views with the entrepreneurial community.

Among dignitaries who attended the summit included US Secretary of State John Kerry and US Commerce Secretary Penny Pritzker.

The four-day IGEM 2013, the region's largest green technology and eco-products exhibition, drew 469 exhibitors from 23 countries including the European Union, Germany, Taiwan, China, South Korea, Japan and Singapore.
