

Experience Winning Factor For New Puteri Umno Chief

KUALA LUMPUR, Oct 13 (Bernama) -- Vast experience in Puteri Umno is among the factors that contributed to the victory of Mas Ermieyati Samsudin as the new Puteri Umno chief for the 2013-2016 term.

Mas Ermieyati, 37, joined Puteri Umno in 2001 as a member of the Alor Gajah Puteri Umno pro-tem committee (2001-2002) before she was selected as the movement's Paya Lebar committee member and branch chief in 2002.

She then became the Alor Gajah Umno Division committee member (2002-2003) and the Alor Gajah Puteri Umno division chief (2003-2004).

The mother of four then went on to become Melaka Puteri Umno chief (2003-2013) and Melaka Barisan Nasional Liaison Committee member (2003-present).

She is also the chairman of the Melaka Youth and Sports Bureau, Melaka Umno Liaison Committee and chief of the Information Technology Unit, Melaka State Liaison Committee.

Mas Ermieyati was also appointed as the Umno Youth and Sports Bureau committee member (2004-2008) and Puteri Umno Special Election Unit chairman (2009-2013).

In the 13th general election, she was elected as Masjid Tanah MP with a majority of 16,200 votes, defeating Mohd Nasaie Ismail of PAS.

Prior to her stint in politics, the Universiti Kebangsaan Malaysia (UKM) law graduate was an advocate and solicitor.

She also has awards such as the Pingat Jasa Kebaktian (2003), Pingat Bakti Belia (2006), Bintang Cemerlang Melaka (2007), Ahli Majlis Negeri Sembilan (2008) and Darjah Seri Melaka (2011) under her belt.
