

Umno Will Hold Small Rallies To Draw Support Of Sungai Limau Voters

YAN, Oct 13 (Bernama) - Umno will hold small rallies to get voters to support the Barisan Nasional (BN) in the Sungai Limau by-election in Kedah on Nov 4.

Umno information chief Datuk Ahmad Maslan said small rallies are needed to draw the 2,000 voters who did not vote for the BN in the May 5 general election.

"We have to campaign door-to-door and do not need to wait for big rallies as they are attended by many outsiders. As such, the message is not delivered," he said after a meeting with BN polling district chiefs here Sunday.

Ahmad who is also Deputy Finance Minister said each polling district should set a target to draw 100 new voters to support BN.

The BN should also recapture the 1,800 Chinese voters who voted for the party in the 1999 and 2004 general elections.

He said there is no reason for Sungai Limau voters to back PAS as the Kedah BN government is now led by Menteri Besar Datuk Mukhriz Tun Dr Mahathir.

The Sungai Limau state seat fell vacant following the death of former Kedah menteri besar Tan Sri Azizan Abdul Razak of PAS on Sept 26.
