

Kota Kinabalu Wanita Umno Wants Umno Election System Reviewed

KOTA KINABALU, Oct 14 (Bernama) -- The Kota Kinabalu Wanita Umno division has suggested that the party election system be reviewed for improvements to smoothen the election process.

Its head, Rosimah Zakaria said among those which must be improved was the ballot paper for the divisions and exco which must be differentiated to facilitate delegates when voting.

"It must be improved so that the election process truly satisfies all quarters. I see the election system as good because it gives the avenue for those qualified to vote but the election process took too long.

"The movement, prior to this, had never expected the election process to be time consuming, from 8am to 7pm," she told reporters at the Communication and Multimedia Ministry Integrated Complex here Monday.

Rosimah recorded her appreciation to Wanita delegates who supported her to remain as the division's Wanita chief.

She also lauded the success of Datuk Seri Shahrizat Abdul Jalil who retained her post as Wanita Umno chief, and Datuk Azizah Mohd Dun who won as Wanita vice-chief.

Meanwhile, the new Kota Kinabalu Umno Youth division chief Mohd Bahrin Abd Karim endeavoured to continue the mission of the previous head to increase the number of professionals in the movement.

He said the movement would work with other Barisan Nasional component parties to increase the number of young voters to win the Kota Kinabalu parliamentary area in the 14th General Election.

Mohd Bahrin said he was proud that the movement, at 25 Umno divisions in Sabah, fully supported Youth chief Khairy Jamaluddin.
