

**Do Not Make The Umno Election Into A Festival - Tengku Adnan

KUALA LUMPUR, Oct 5 (Bernama) -- Umno secretary-general Datuk Seri Tengku Adnan Tengku Mansor today reminded party members to comply with the party regulations and ethics and not turn the party election into a festival.

"There is no need for us to create a situation where the Umno election becomes a festival. Don't. We want to choose leaders, not to choose a singer or 'tukang karut' (the creative leader in a dikir barat group). We want to elect leaders for the country's future

"What is contained in the party ethics, we can do. Otherwise, don't. If there is anyone caught (for violating the ethics), don't blame any quarters," he told reporters after visiting the victims of a fire at the Perumahan Awam Sementara Air Panas A near here Saturday.

He said this in response to complaints by some leaders and candidates on the party regulations and ethics which do not allow candidates to conduct their own campaign, but to only promote themselves at functions arranged by the Umno liaison committees in their respective states.

Earlier, Tengku Adnan, who is Federal Territories Minister handed over contributions to the fire victims and told them that they would be moved to the PPR Bukit Jalil.

He also ordered Kuala Lumpur City Hall to make arrangements to move the other 186 residents, currently occupying the wooden houses there, also to the PPR Bukit Jalil.

"We will provide the logistics for them to move," he added.
