

**Najib Arrives In Bandar Seri Begawan**

BANDAR SERI BEGAWAN, Oct 8 (Bernama) -- Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak arrived here Tuesday night to attend the 23rd Asean Summit and its related summits scheduled on Wednesday and Thursday.

The special aircraft carrying the prime minister and wife, Datin Seri Rosmah Mansor, touched down at the Brunei International Airport at 8.45pm.

They were greeted upon arrival by Malaysian Foreign Minister Datuk Seri Anifah Aman and Malaysian High Commissioner to Brunei Datuk Awang Sahak Awang Salleh.

Najib, who is leading the Malaysian delegation to the summits, had earlier attended the Asia Pacific Economic Cooperation (Apec) Leaders Summit in Bali.

Asean leaders are expected to adopt several key documents during the summit, which includes the Bandar Seri Begawan Statement on the Asean Community's Post-2015 Vision that was initiated by Malaysia.

The document will launch Asean's efforts to evolve and elaborate its post-2015 vision.

Besides the 23rd Asean Summit, Datuk Seri Najib will also be attending a series of related summits with Asean's dialogue partners, namely China, Japan, South Korea, Australia, New Zealand, India, the United States and the United Nations.
