

Umno Polls: Khaled Reminds Delegates To Choose Wisely

JOHOR BAHRU, Oct 8 (Bernama) -- Johor Umno chief Datuk Seri Mohamed Khaled Nordin Tuesday reminded voting delegates at Umno's polls this month to choose wisely as a good leadership line up was crucial for the party in facing the 14th General Election.

The session to introduce MT candidates took a different turn when four girls got up from their seats and walked around the hall together carrying pictures of Datuk Seri Azalina Othman Said when Mohamed Khaled announced her name.

Another name that was a hit among the crowd was Khairy Jamaluddin who is defending his Umno Youth chief post.

There was thunderous applause when he was introduced.
